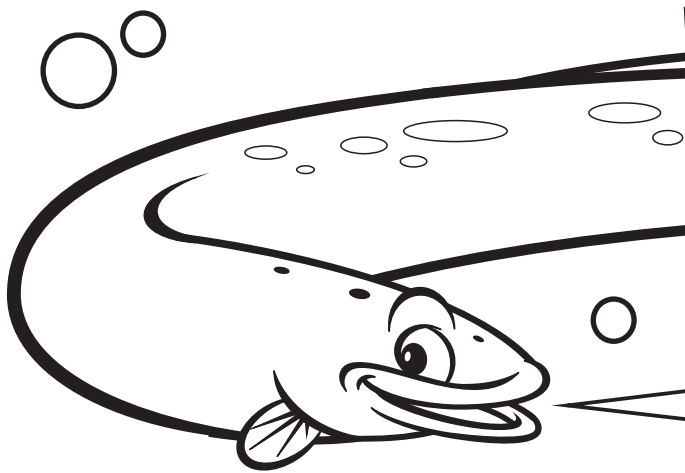
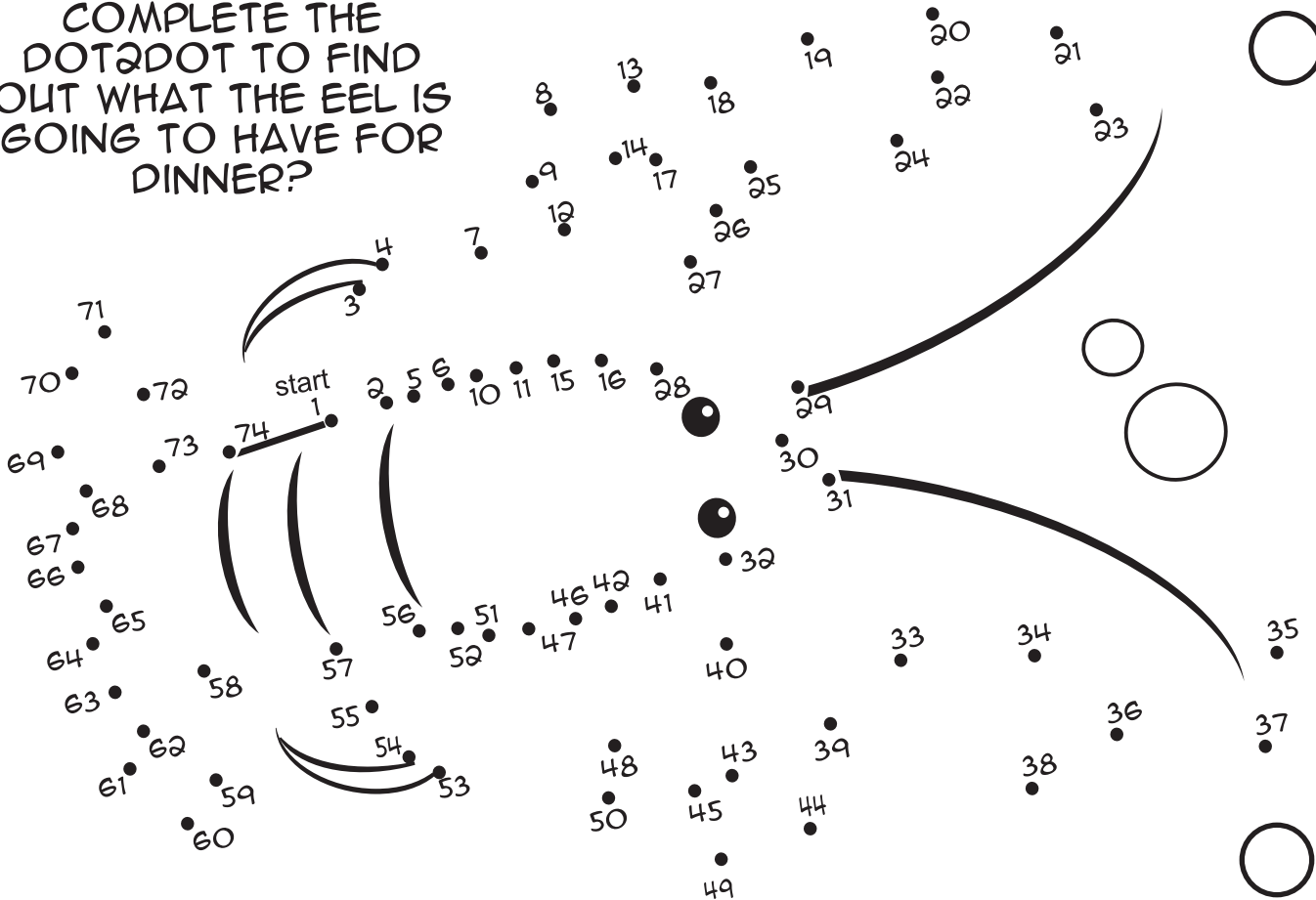

What do Eel's Eat?

Eels are opportunistic feeders and eat all sorts of foods. Small Eels will feed on insect larvae, worms and water snails. When they get bigger, they begin to feed on fish, carrion and pretty much anything else they can find. They will also eat fresh-water crayfish and small birds. Eels usually hunt by night and by smell rather than sight. Eels have a well-developed sense of smell. They have tube nostrils that protrude from their head, which can look like horns on their head!
